KINGDOM BOUNDARIES

HISTORICAL TIMELINE (2013-2023)



2013

- **September**, board was established
- Started with 1 man; gave him companionship, as well as rides from the prison to work, and both moral & spiritual support
- Later, upon his release we found & furnished an apartment for him with the help of *Justice For All*
- Attained 501(c)3 status (*nonprofit status*)

2014

- **September**, we rented a room at the Arena Motel which could help 3 men
- **October**, we rented a 2nd room, expanding our ministry to now help 6 men
- **December**, we purchased an apartment building at **417 S. Summit Ave.**
- We renovated space for residents & an office



2015

- **March**, started accepting men at . . .
<< The Carpenter's Shop
- **December**, with our new building we could now provide ministry to 9 men
- *News was spreading!* Our waiting list of men still incarcerated was growing quickly...

2017

- **January**, purchased the building next door, expanding our ministry to 11 more men at . . .
The Master's House >>
- This growth meant we needed to hire more staff and convert part of the space in the first building to another office

2018

- Bought the house next door, now known as . . .

<< *The Holy Spirit Inn*

- With the addition of a 3rd building, we were able to add 2 offices & hire a 4th staff member
- Currently, Kingdom Boundaries is providing both housing and daily ministry to **20 men** at a time!

NEW CREATION

One of the greatest blessings as a believer is that we are a new creation!

The old has passed away, and a new life begins. For any believer, this is easier said than done. It is the same and even more so for those who have been incarcerated. They often find themselves asking, "Is there life after prison, or is my sentence/sin a life sentence?" They walk a life of fear, confusion, shame and worry about life on the "outside". Who can they trust, turn to, confide in? The options are usually not very good and lead to these men and women going back to prison.

Kingdom Boundaries Prison Aftercare (KBPA) seeks to change the world, one former inmate at a time, by breaking the cycle of recidivism* by introducing them to the Gospel of Christ.

****Recidivism is the tendency of a convicted criminal to repeat or reoffend a crime after already receiving punishment or serving their sentence.***

As an approved halfway house, Kingdom Boundaries Prison Aftercare (KBPA), which was established in 2013, seeks to increase its resident capacity, while also improving their sociological health, mental health, physical safety, and most importantly, their faith development. KBPA does this by personal discipleship focused on being Christ-like, personal responsibility, integrity, employment stability, financial stewardship, time management, and restoring relationships with family, friends, and the community. Residents at KBPA pay a reduced rate for rent, maintain employment in the community and attend church and regular Bible studies. Our vision has remained the same through the years, but is now expanding to help even more males, as well as, add housing for women now, too.

THE CHALLENGE:

\$3.5 million

An ongoing challenge with this ministry has always been finding safe, clean, affordable and accountable housing for our men as they move out of the Carpenter's Shop and the Master's House (*our 2 current apartments on Summit Avenue.*) The purchase of this property on Dakota Avenue allows KB the ability to offer much-needed housing to men as they continue on their journey to becoming productive members of society.

The range of gifts we need to implement this plan is shown on the next page. Your generous gift to support Kingdom Boundaries will help us capture the stewardship opportunity of expanding our ministry for men, and beginning a much-needed women's ministry.

Aftercare is a program seeking to establish relationships between mentors and individuals in prison who are anticipating release. To provide continuity, upon release Kingdom Boundaries helps these individuals transition back into society through a mentoring program. The goal is to help the individual attain a fulfilling and productive life.

We all need aftercare. We need Christian brothers & sisters to encourage us as we live for Christ. As important as this is for us living outside of prison, it is even more important for those who have lived in prison or have been recently released.

Financial Support

***Recidivism** is the return rate of inmates going back to prison.
