KBPA's vision and ministry continues to expand

God had put in the hearts of several individuals to come along side men as they returned to society from incarceration. With the vision to lower recidivism (the rate individuals go back to prison) by fostering Christian character one person at a time.

Below is a timeline of how God has been blessing KB. It shows the expansion of the ministry of Kingdom Boundaries since its inception in 2013. And in June, KB purchased land (next page) and has a vision to build a new facility (also next page).

- ◆ 2013 September - KBPA Board of Directors established and 501(c)3 non-profit status established
- ◆ 2014 September - rented a room at the Arena Motel, capacity of 3 men
- ◆ 2014 October - rented a second room at the Arena Motel, capacity of 3 men
- ◆ 2014 December - purchased apartment building called "The Carpenter Shop"
- ◆ 2015 March - started accepting men for "The Carpenter Shop", capacity 9 men
- ◆ 2017 January - purchased second apartment building - "The Master's House" capacity 11 men
- ◆ 2018 March - purchased third location called "The Holy Spirit Inn" capacity 4 men

Since the creation of Kingdom Boundaries Prison Aftercare 190+ men have lived at Kingdom Boundaries and have gone through the program.
